Celebrating the Legacy of Sir C. V. Raman

Preface

This report is submitted as part of the requirements for the Seminar on Raman Effect on National Science Day at Netaji Mahavidyalaya. The seminar was chosen to explore the dignity of the National Science Day, given its relevance to the Raman Effect. The objective is to provide a comprehensive overview of Raman Spectroscopy and its applications, cultivate a scientific mind among students, and encourage them to pursue research in the field.

Introduction:

The seminar entitled “Raman Effect on National Science Day” was organized by the Department of Physics in collaboration with the IQAC, Netaji Mahavidyalaya, Arambagh, to honour the discovery of the Raman Effect by Sir C.V. Raman in 1928 (awarded the first Nobel Prize in 1930 as an Indian Scientist). This seminar focused on the historical background of the National Science Day and the discovery of the Raman Effect. The speakers also covered Raman scattering, its impact on molecular structures, and its applications.

Purpose:

To raise awareness of the importance of science, cultivate and stimulate a scientific, curious and evidence-based thinking mind in the pupil.

Objective:

- i) Celebrating the discovery of the Raman Effect and Raman’s 1930 Nobel Prize.
- ii) Recognizing the impact of the Raman Effect on understanding molecular structures.
- iii) To encourage research and highlight the practical applications of the Raman Effect in different fields, such as in Raman spectroscopy and daily life.
- iv) Nurturing curiosity, analytical thinking, and creativity in students.
- v) Inspiring the students to pursue careers in science and technology.
- vi) Job opportunities in the Raman Effect field, such as Research Scientists, Lab Technicians, instrumentations, etc.
- vii) To encourage research and highlight practical applications in technology and daily life
- viii) Discussing the future of science, technology & innovation.

Highlights:

- 1) **Specialty of National Science Day:** This seminar focused on the importance of the National Science Day.
- 2) **Discovery of the Raman Effect:** This seminar covered the history of the discovery of the Raman Effect.
- 3) **Knowing the Raman Effect:** This seminar focuses on the phenomenon of changing the wavelength of light by molecular interactions.
- 4) **Significance and application:** This seminar provides the significance and application of the Raman Effect in the research field.

- **Honoring and commemoration of Dr. CV Raman:** The patron, Dr. Sachchidananda Roy; the resource person, Prof. Abhijit Chakraborty; the co-patron, Dr. Bishwanath Gorai; and the convener, Dr. Binay Malakar, of the seminar present a garland; the faculties and two representatives of the students present flowers; and burn incense and a candle to the portrait of Dr. C.V. Raman to reverently him reverent homage at 11.40 am.

- **Delivering the significance of the day and the message to the students:** At 11.55 am, the patron and co-patron introduced the theme and significance of the seminar. They delivered a message to the students to encourage them and nurture curiosity, analytical thinking, and creativity.
- **Introductory Speech:** Dr. Binay Malakar, the convener of the seminar, delivered a speech on the historical background and the dignity of the day. He also focused on the C.V. Raman, Raman Effect, and Raman Spectroscopy.
- **Resource Person's Speech:** Prof. Abhijit Chakraborty, Professor and Head of the Department of Physics, Burdwan University, the seminar's The

resource person delivered the main lecture on the discovery of the Raman Effect, the concept of Raman scattering, and its modern applications. He has pointed out that the development of the scientific temper, humanism, and the spirit of inquiry and reform are the Fundamental Duties of every citizen, as outlined in Article 51A(h) of the Indian Constitution, located in Part IV-A. He discussed Dr. C.V. Raman's early life, academic career, occupational career, research work, and his nomination for and receipt of the Nobel Prize for the Raman Effect. He also discussed the Raman Effect and its application. His deliberation includes the contributions of the first Indian women in science.

- **In-house Speaker:** The in-house speaker, Dr. Somenath Jalal, discussed how the historical mystery was solved by science and showed some historical techniques for art, architecture, sculpture, etc. He has also included some modern techniques for microscopy and microanalysis. The second in-house speaker, Dr. Chayan Kanchan Karmakar, highlighted the applications and advantages of Raman Spectroscopy in our daily lives. He also specifies the research institutes, universities, and IITs that offer research facilities in Raman Spectroscopy.
- **Feedback:** In the next session the feedback from the students are collected from the students which has been attached to the report.

Outcome

The seminar enhanced students' understanding of the Raman Effect and its applications in modern science. Participants gained knowledge of molecular structure analysis and developed a greater interest in experimental science and research. The program successfully promoted scientific awareness among students.
