With the increasing emphasis on digital academic records under the National Education Policy (NEP), the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID has become an essential component for students as well as academicians in higher education. To create awareness among the faculties about its significance and practical usage, our institution organized a seminar specially for the Teachers and Non-Teaching members of our college, focusing on the importance of the ABC ID and DigiLocker.

The seminar aimed to familiarize faculties and non-teaching members of Netaji Mahavidyalaya, with the benefits of maintaining Confidential data like PAN, Driving License, Aadhaar ID, and most importantly academic credentials digitally, ensuring easy access, secure storage, and seamless academic credit transfer. This will be helpful in doing MOOCS and Swayam Courses online for faculties. The online Swayam courses is made mandatory for Faculty Development and Faculty Induction courses. Along with informative discussions, a live hands-on demonstration session was conducted to guide students step-by-step in creating their ABC ID through DigiLocker. The interactive discussion and question-answer session helped clarify doubts and enhanced Teacher's understanding of digital academic documentation. We believe this will also spread the awareness among their students from the respective 24 departments of Netaji Mahavidyalaya and thus serve the purpose as well.
