For the first 9 years, however, it was affiliated to the Calcutta University as an intermediate college. In 1957, The college was upgraded to a degree college. In 1960, the year of foundation of the University of Burdwan, this college was affiliated to this University. Since then, with a gradual march the college has assumed its present status. Whereas in 1948, it started with only 96 students, its present roll strength is nearly 4120 having as many as 24 honours Departments. Besides, the college offers the Six months' certificate course in Yoga. It is noteworthy to mention in this context that the Dept. of Bengali has been running Post Graduation Program since 2008.
