Policy on the Green Campus Initiatives

- Entry of vehicles especially fuel run vehicles as used by the students, teaching and non-teaching faculty and visitors must be restricted in the campus so as to keep pollution under check
- Events that encourage participation of the students as well as teaches, teachers and all other inmates of the college in plantation programme will be held regularly in such occasion as in the World Environment Day, during the Van Mahotsav week, the World Forest Day
- A fruit garden as well as medicinal plants garden that already exists will be maintained with proper scientific inputs and will be further developed
- As the college is situated in a village our endeavour will be continued to make it greener by adding more plants even beyond the college campus
- To resist the wrath of flood related erosion especially on the river banks that fall into the surroundings of the college the objective is to remain keen on augmenting forestation every year after the flood season
